The intention of this memo and future memo's is to keep everyone up to date on the most recent developments regarding the current Pandemic and State of Emergency.

Recently Governor Hogan has issued Executive Order (EO) 20-04-15-01, requiring the use of face coverings under certain circumstances. As defined in the EO face coverings means a covering that fully covers a person's nose and mouth, but is not a Medical-Grade Mask. The term "Face Covering" includes, without limitation, scarves and bandanas.

The requirement for these face coverings is specifically noted for Foodservice Establishments, Public Transportation and Retail Establishments. These are further defined in the EO.

Specifics for construction jobsites was not addressed in the EO. However, some GC's have sent out memo's, requiring such face coverings. Please keep in mind that Medical Grade Masks are not required. If you are unable to attain masks; scarves, bandanas, homemade coverings of any kind are accepted.

As a company we ask that all employees have the proper respect for their fellow employees and wear face coverings when they cannot maintain a distance of six feet as recommended by the CDC. The law of "common sense" steps in to govern this request.
